



# Visual Harvesting Competition



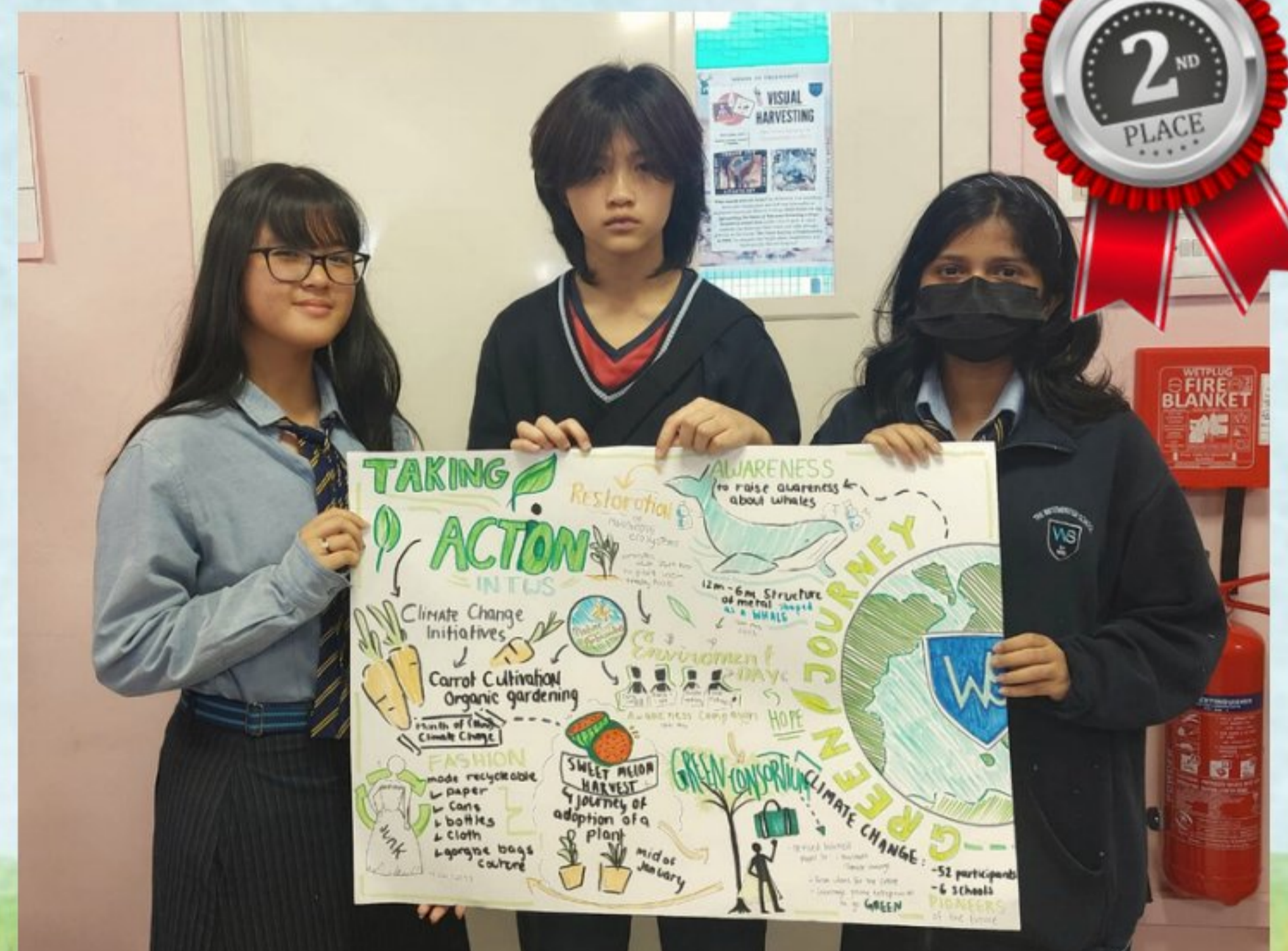
An Initiative by the House Of Tolerance
