AL QUDRA LAKES, CLEAN UP DRIVE 14TH OF FEBRUARY 2026, SATURDAY


As part of our commitment to environmental sustainability and community service, students from the Higher Secondary and Sixth Form sections of The Westminster School, Dubai participated in a clean-up drive at Al Qudra Lakes on 14 February 2026. The initiative was organized in collaboration with Eedama and aimed to raise awareness about environmental conservation while encouraging students to take an active role in protecting natural ecosystems.

Equipped with the necessary materials and safety equipment provided by the organizers, students worked together to collect litter from the area surrounding the lakes. Through their collective efforts, participants removed 21.31 kg of general waste and 0.445 kg of cigarette butts, helping to restore the cleanliness of this important natural habitat.

The activity required dedication, teamwork, and perseverance, as students spent several hours cleaning the area under the guidance of knowledgeable and supportive environmental facilitators. Their encouragement and expertise helped students better understand the impact of littering on wildlife, water bodies, and the wider environment.

Beyond the clean-up itself, the event served as a valuable learning experience. Students gained a deeper appreciation for environmental stewardship, the importance of responsible waste disposal, and the role individuals can play in creating a more sustainable future. The collaboration also provided an excellent opportunity for students from different year groups to work together, strengthen teamwork skills, and contribute meaningfully to the community.
